# Nominations Now Accepted

The AFMRD and the American Academy of Family Physicians (AAFP) are now accepting nominations for the 2017 <u>Nikitas J.</u> Zervanos Outstanding Program Director Award.

To be considered for this prestigious honor, nominees must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Be a current member of the AAFP and the AFMRD
- Be actively directing a family medicine program for at least 10 years
  - Nominees who actively directed a family medicine program for at least 10 years who either transitioned into a new position or will be transitioning into a new position will be considered eligible to receive this award. Transitions must be

within 24 months of the date the award is presented.

- Demonstrate leadership and advancement of the specialty
- · Have served as a mentor to residents or medical students
- Have made contributions to the community he or she serves
- Have made contributions to the organizations of the family of family medicine
- Not be a current member of the AFMRD Board of Directors or the AAFP Commission on Education
- Not have served as a Board member of the AFMRD within the last three years
- Have significant leadership experience at the national level

The award will be presented only if an outstanding candidate exists. The recipient will be recognized during the 2017 PDW and RPS Residency Education Symposium in Kansas City, Missouri, and will receive free registration to the PDW or RPS portion of the conference.

Nominations are accepted only through the <u>online nomination</u> <u>form</u>. The required supporting documents are a current curriculum vitae and at least two letters of endorsement. The deadline for nominations is Friday, September 30, 2016.


# Website Tip of the Month

Can't recall where you saw a particular AFMRD item of interest? Was it on the AFMRD email discussion forum (list serve)? Or was it maybe in the PD Toolbox? Or perhaps you saw it on one of the AFMRD website pages?

No problem.

Simply log in to <u>afmrd.org</u> and type in a search term. The site's robust search engine will conduct a global search that will return results from the PD Toolbox, the AFMRD email discussions (which are all conveniently archived on the website), and all other pages on the website. (See example below.)

Remember, you must be logged in. If you are not, the search results will not display members-only content, such as discussions or toolbox content.



After your initial search, you will have the option to do an advanced search, which can further narrow the results:
