New AFMRD Membership Category

During the 2015 Business Meeting, the AFMRD membership amended the bylaws to include a new membership category: International Associate Membership.

With this new category, a family physician in an existing or developing international family medicine residency program that has not achieved Accreditation Council on Graduate Medical Education - International (ACGME-I) accreditation may become an international associate member of this organization upon payment of dues. The international associate member has access to web resources, but cannot vote, hold office, serve on committees, or participate on the discussion forum.
