Last-Minute Reminders to Complete National Graduate Survey

If you haven't yet done so, please remind your graduates to complete the American Board of Family Medicine (ABFM) National Graduate Survey. **The deadline is December 31**. We have <u>sample emails</u> for you on our website.

The information from the survey will be used to create aggregate reports for each residency class's satisfaction with training, preparation for practice, and scope of practice, intended to be shared with the residency program. The programs can then use the information to improve the quality of residency training. This will fulfill the ACGME RC-FM requirement for programs to conduct a graduate survey.

Per the ABFM privacy policy, data will be shared only in aggregate and with all identifiers removed. To protect confidentiality, the ABFM will not provide programs with their own program-specific data in 2017 if fewer than 3 graduates responded to the survey; instead, they would get data in 2018 on combined results over two years.

Opportunity to Serve as Director of CERA Program Director Surveys

CERA is now accepting applications for individuals interested in serving on the <u>CAFM Research Alliance (CERA)</u> Steering Committee as the Director of Program Director Surveys. This position starts April 1, 2017 and is open to anyone with research expertise and is an active member of any CAFM organization. Preference will be given to program directors or associate directors.

Survey Directors serve two-year terms with the option to renew for an additional term. Responsibilities include:

- Participating in two half-day meetings plus conference calls/email discussions as needed
- Reviewing proposals for survey inclusion
- Appointing and managing CERA mentors
- Ensuring that surveys are of high quality and completed on time

Travel costs to attend CERA meetings are reimbursed by CERA. The mission of CERA is to set within family medicine a standard for medical education research that is rigorous and generalizable; to provide mentoring and education to junior researchers; to facilitate collaboration between medical education researchers; and to guide the specialty by providing leadership and vision in the arena of medical education research.
